Electric Dog Fences
Set back 30 ft. from any road & 20 ft. from all other boundaries

Exterior Lighting

Must be down-shielded. Landscape illumination prohibited

Parties / Gatherings

Outdoor music allowed until 11 PM All music at other times should not be audible by neighbors

Parking on Village Roads

Notify LHPD if hosting an event in order to avoid guest ticketing

Golf Carts / Quads / Non Street-Legal Vehicles
Prohibited on Village roads
